

THE LOS ANGELES RIVER REVITALIZATION MASTER PLAN



The City of Los Angeles invites you to provide input on the draft of the **Los Angeles River Revitalization Master Plan!**

Mark your calendars for a presentation and discussion of the draft Los Angeles River Revitalization Master Plan (LARRMP), intended to form the blueprint for the future of the Los Angeles River!

At several public workshops over the past 16 months, participants have worked with the City of Los Angeles to identify five (5) Opportunity Areas where River revitalization efforts can be focused. The process included a comprehensive visioning effort and identification of 20 initial areas, which were refined to the current five Opportunity Areas. Modifications for greening the channel and adjacent neighborhoods along the entire 32 miles of the River within the City of Los Angeles are also part of the Plan. Public input has been a critical component of the process ever since the City began thinking about how best to revitalize the River.

The next round of LARR Master Plan workshops will be held jointly with the Public Hearings on its combined draft Programmatic Environmental Impact Report/ Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (PEIR/PEIS) during February 2007.

Each of the three meetings will begin with a one-hour

Master Plan discussion followed by a fifteen-minute break; the PEIR/PEIS Public Hearings will take place for the final one hour and fifteen minutes. During the PEIR/PEIS hearing, participants may submit both oral and written comments on the draft environmental document, which will then become part of the project's public record. The Public Hearings are an important component of the public outreach and are designed to comply with both the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

Participants will also learn more about the LARRMP's proposed River Improvement Overlay (RIO). Staff from the Department of City Planning will be available to discuss the RIO and workshop attendees will have the opportunity to provide input on the RIO's possible boundaries and guidelines. The RIO community planning process will involve additional future public meetings, which will take place after the LARRMP is adopted.
